Reporting to the Program Manager Peer Support Services, the Peer Recovery Educator is responsible for developing educational resource materials, presentations, and workshops on self-management, recovery and overall wellbeing. They will facilitate Recovery College courses, supports volunteers and students throughout the Recovery College experience which include hope, collaboration, personal growth, recovery planning, communication, creativity, critical thinking, problem solving, managing information, capacity building and inclusivity. Peer Recovery Educators use their own recovery story to inspire hope in others and share their practical, first-hand knowledge of strategies for promoting mental health and available mental health resources. The Peer Recovery Educator will work with the Program Manager Peer Support Services and CMHA National on the implementation and evaluation of the Recovery College program.

Recovery College is offered at multiple CMHA locations across Canada. It is built on the belief that people with lived experience have expert knowledge about recovery and that peer support is an essential ingredient to wellness. All Recovery College courses are co-developed and co-facilitated by people with lived experience. Courses are open to anyone who wishes to improve their wellness and are offered free of charge. Each course has stated learning objectives and the effectiveness and impact of our courses are being continually evaluated.

Normal hours of work are 37.50 hours per week. The normal workday is 8 hours, including a 30-minute unpaid lunch break. Travel throughout Grey-Bruce is required as well as some evening work and overtime.
