	<p><b>Family Support</b></p> <p>This program provides support, information, consultation, education and community development services to benefit family members of adults with serious mental illness</p>
	<p><b>Peer Support</b></p> <p>This program's staff have lived experience with mental illness and/or addictions. They assist with system navigation, information, education and peer support to those living with mental illness and/or addiction</p>
	<p><b>Recovery College</b></p> <p>Peer Recovery Educators develop, coordinate and deliver corporate education to community partners. Peer Recovery Educators use their own recovery story to inspire hope in others and share their practical, first-hand knowledge of strategies for promoting mental health and available mental health resources</p>
	<p><b>Residential Support</b></p> <p>This program provides psychosocial rehabilitation and residential support services for adults who are living with serious mental illness and/or addictions and who reside in our group homes</p>
	<p><b>G&amp;B House</b></p> <p>This is an abstinence-based program that provides recovery services for men in a residential setting. Programs follow the 12 Step model. Staff are in addiction recovery</p>
	<p><b>Case Management</b></p> <p>This program provides both individual and group supports for independent living including supportive counselling, life skills training and case management</p>
	<p><b>Life Enrichment</b></p> <p>This program supports clients with activities of daily living and maintaining their living environment for those living with serious mental illness and addictions work within the context of a client centered, harm reductions transitional housing program</p>
	<p><b>Social Recreation &amp; Rehabilitation / Group Services</b></p> <p>This program provides group recreation activities to enable clients to access psychosocial rehabilitation</p>
	<p><b>Addiction Counselling</b> (Bachelor's degree students)</p> <p>This program provides comprehensive assessment, treatment planning, consultation, referral, supportive counselling, follow-up and case management services to individuals and/or family members concerned about a substance abuse problem</p>
	<p><b>Court Support</b> (Bachelor's degree students)</p> <p>This program assists individuals with mental health or addictions concerns who are involved with the Criminal Justice System</p>
	<p><b>Mobile Mental Health &amp; Addiction Response Team</b> (Bachelor's degree students)</p> <p>This program works with First Responders including EMS, police and hospitals to provide crisis assessment, intervention and resolution with the goal of reducing hospital admittances</p>
	<p><b>Mental Health Counselling</b> (Master's degree students)</p> <p>This program provides clients with serious mental illness or those at risk with access to mental health counselling</p>
	<p><b>Concurrent Disorders Counselling</b> (Master's degree students)</p> <p>This program provides one to one counselling, assessment and referral for those with diagnosed co-occurring serious mental illness and substance use disorder</p>
