	Family Support
	This program provides support, information, consultation, education and community development services to
	benefit family members of adults with serious mental illness
	Peer Support
	This program's staff have lived experience with mental illness and/or addictions. They assist with system navigation, information, education and peer support to those living with mental illness and/or addiction
	Recovery College
	Peer Recovery Educators develop, coordinate and deliver corporate education to community partners. Peer Recovery Educators use their own recovery story to inspire hope in others and share their practical, first-hand knowledge of strategies for promoting mental health and available mental health resources
	Residential Support
	This program provides psychosocial rehabilitation and residential support services for adults who are living with serious mental illness and/or addictions and who reside in our group homes
	G&B House
	This is an abstinence-based program that provides recovery services for men in a residential setting. Programs follow the 12 Step model. Staff are in addiction recovery
	Case Management
	This program provides both individual and group supports for independent living including supportive counselling, life skills training and case management
	Life Enrichment
	This program supports clients with activities of daily living and maintaining their living environment for those living with serious mental illness and addictions work within the context of a client centered, harm reductions transitional housing program
	Social Recreation & Rehabilitation / Group Services
	This program provides group recreation activities to enable clients to access psychosocial rehabilitation
	Addiction Counselling (Bachelor's degree students)
	This program provides comprehensive assessment, treatment planning, consultation, referral, supportive counselling, follow-up and case management services to individuals and/or family members concerned about a substance abuse problem
	Court Support (Bachelor's degree students)
	This program assists individuals with mental health or addictions concerns who are involved with the Criminal Justice System
	Mobile Mental Health & Addiction Response Team (Bachelor's degree students)
	This program works with First Responders including EMS, police and hospitals to provide crisis assessment,
	intervention and resolution with the goal of reducing hospital admittances
	Mental Health Counselling (Master's degree students)
	This program provides clients with serious mental illness or those at risk with access to mental health counselling
	Concurrent Disorders Counselling (Master's degree students)
	This program provides one to one counselling, assessment and referral for those with diagnosed co-occurring serious mental illness and substance use disorder
